6. Treasurers Report

Very little else will come in or out of the accounts now before the end of the financial year on Aug 31^{st} . The League has a surplus of £2529.21 and the Association a surplus of £4084.56 so despite a brave attempt to spend some money we actually made ~£6,500 profit! World Masters contributed £2729.40 to the Association profit where again we had anticipated funding a deficit. It's possible that we may have to pay levies to BC to cover the insurance but this would amount to less than £2,500.

8. Year Book

Year book have been completed and printed and are now being sent out. Point of this was to have a printed document to show to a landowner exactly what we do, where we go and promote Cyclocross to a landowner/venue/organisers. Should be a real gamechanger in terms of showing what CX is all about.
